About the Artist:

Mary Fuscaldo's artwork has graced the covers of American Spoon Foods catalogs, ForeWord Magazine, Manitou Magazine published by the Sleeping Bear National Park Visitors Bureau, juried into "Art of the Sleeping Bear Dunes" book and was chosen for 5 Northern Michigan festival posters. Her paintings have also appeared in Plein Air Magazine, Southwest Art Magazine and Sedona Magazine. Traverse Magazine and the Traverse area Express published articles about her work. The Traverse City Visitors Bureau commissioned the painting "Northern Vineyard" to highlight the Grand Traverse Area for the National Governors Conference in North Carolina and subsequently purchased 2 paintings. The painting then was purchased by Forty Five North Winery for their Conservancy Wine label. In 2002 she and author Erin Anderson wrote/illustrated "Look About You - A Magical Childhood in Michigan's Wild Places". The best selling book was a finalist in 2003 for the Great Lakes Booksellers Association Book of the Year Award. A painting was chosen from the book for the Mazza Museum of International Art from Picture Books at the University of Findlay in Findlay, Ohio.
